This role is a unique opportunity for a passionate MSI Class Teacher with an interest in special needs, to lead and manage the provision and outcomes for a small number of SEND children. These pupils may be working below age-related expectations and have a strong focus on their sensory needs.

This is through the delivery of the sensory curriculum through a blended learning approach with a balance of in-class and bespoke learning experiences such as sensory play, forest school and gardening; as well as intensive support to meet the children's EHCP/IEP targets.

It is vital that the successful candidate has both knowledge of the EYFS and a passion for SEND children. There is an emphasis on being able to work effectively and closely with parents, outside agencies and liaising with class teachers, SENCO and support staff.

Moreover, a knowledge of send paperwork and the ability to organise and manage the bespoke and personalised provision is essential.

The starting salary is £35,000, which may increase following a successful probationary period.
